- Vendor fees must be paid at least 4 weeks prior to the event.
- All vendors must occupy the space provided and specified by the festival Kommittee.
- Vendors must provide their own tables, chairs, tents lights and extension cords (if electricity is needed).
- Vendors should be packed up and ready to leave by midnight.
- This is a rain or shine event and no refunds will be given.
- Vendors assume responsibility for any items left on the festival site after hours.
- Applications will be accepted until all spaces have been filled.
- Tents must be of flame-retardant material.
